A very strange acid-trance EP that has been licensed by Rising High from Pod Communications in Germany. The A-side's Mihon #3 begins with a haunting synth sound that gives way to a throbbing acid bassline reminiscent of Phuture's Acid Trax. Slowly the beats fade in and the track develops into a wonderfully ambient acid epic. About halfway through Mihon #3 a mildly thudding beat adapts it for the dancefloor. Marvellous. Mihon #1 is a techno cut more reminiscent of some of Joey Beltram's finer moments, complete with crashing cymbals and haunting basslines. Mihon #2 is the strangest track here as the first part of it consists entirely of various samples of computers, transporters, doors and transmitters from the early Star Trek series. They are ingeniously woven together and fit perfectly with the ambient synth sounds that fade in over the top. Very spacey. This single is unlikely to sell enough to appear in the Network Chart but expect healthy sales from fans of Rising High.





ONGAKU: 'Mihon' (Pod) Germany

The current big acid track along with the awesome 'Hardfloor' (apparently picked up by Rising High). Atom Heart is involved along with two blokes called Ata and Heiko and it comes in three very different versions. 'Mihon No 1' is hard and trancey with Detroit reversals. 'No 2' follows the current German penchant for an ambient mix on every record. 'No 3' is the one — eight minutes of 303 trance-terror starting with a lonely squirt building all the time with haunting space-strings.

3. DEFINITIVE TWO-I'M STRONGER NOW (DeConstruction)

The theme from Channel Four's Italian footie remixed by progressive darlings 'Acorn Arts'.

4. TRANSFORM - TRANSFORMATION (Eternity)

Hypnotic trancey beats laced with surfy scat vocals, a sort of Crystal Waters on Angel Dust.

5. SNAP - EXTERMINATE (Logic)

The good news is that they've made a track to equal, some would say surpass, the awesome 'Rhythm'. The really good news is they've kicked out that buffoon, Turbo 'B'. Hurrah!

6. USURA-OPEN YOUR MIND (Deconstruction)

The KLF-sampling, stompy, high N-R-G previously on Milan's Italian Style label.

7. BM EX - APPOLONOA (UCR)

DJ superstar Sasha's first vinyl outing in his own right, and very good it is, too. Hard house beats, driving percussion and slightly cheesy but effective piano breaks. Hands in the air!

8. CLUB 69-LET MEBEYOUR UNDERWEAR (ffrr)


Previously hard to find dub smash, in which disco diva Kim Cooper addresses a subject all too often ignored in dance music men's pants.
